Sumner County Schools offers students the opportunity to participate in a virtual school environment. By using electronic learning, students independently complete coursework for high school graduation.

Interested in Full-Time

- Student or parent should call E.B. Wilson at (615) 451-4517 and schedule an interview.
- Student **and** parent *must* interview with the E.B. Wilson administrative staff. The student's transcript and attendance will be reviewed. The tuition is \$125 per semester. **Note: If a student qualifies for free/reduced lunch, the tuition may be waived.**
- Newly enrolled students are required to attend one class session, four days per week for four weeks. The class sessions are as follows: 9:00am-12:00pm, 1:00pm-4:00pm, and 2:30pm-5:30pm.
- After four weeks, if the student is in good academic standing and has attended the required sessions; he or she will be able to work virtually from home. However, all students are still required to attend one class session each week.

Interested in Part-Time

- Students must discuss plans with their school counselor.
- Counselor will recommend classes and forward information to E.B. Wilson.
- Student **and** parent **must** attend registration night at E.B. Wilson. **Note: No charge for part-time** students.

Other Information about E. B. Wilson

- All tests are taken at E. B. Wilson with a certified teacher.
- Transportation is the responsibility of the student/family.
- Though not essential, it is helpful if students have access to an internet-accessible computer beyond E. B. Wilson.

Located on the Volunteer State Community College campus, MCHS is a collaborative effort between Sumner County Schools and Volunteer State Community College.

Students must take the ACT to be eligible to apply for the Middle College High School. A composite of 19 or higher with subtests of at least 19 in reading, 18 in English, and 19 in math are required.

Students must have at least 10 high school credits to be eligible. The Middle College High School is a designed for juniors and seniors who are motivated, hardworking, responsible, and driven.

The potential to graduate high school and receive an associate's degree at the same time is an opportunity available for the student who has a strong work ethic and never misses an assignment or class.
