

**Comes in
Close Contact
but
Asymptomatic**



Students

- Students who were in close contact with a COVID-19 positive individual are encouraged to consult with their healthcare provider prior to returning to school.
- The student must quarantine for 10 days from the last exposure to the positive individual. Exposure date is day 0, day 1 is the following day. Student may return after completion of day 10.
- A student may return after 7 days from the last exposure to the positive individual if they provide a negative test result upon their return to school.
 - The student must submit proof of the negative test result to the attendance clerk before returning to class.
 - The negative test must be dated on the 6th or 7th day of the quarantine period.
 - Even with a negative test, the earliest a student may return is after completion of day 7.
- Students will be screened upon their return.
- All COVID-19 related absences will be excused with a parent or doctor's note.
- Students can continue learning at home via Sumner Connect and Google Classroom if preferred or recommended by their health care provider.

Staff

- Staff who were in close contact with a COVID-19 positive individual are encouraged to monitor for symptoms and consult with One to One if symptoms develop.
- If a COVID-19 test is recommended by One to One, the staff member should quarantine at home until test results are available. A negative test result OR return to work note must be presented prior to their return.
- If the employee is not exhibiting symptoms, they may continue to work as a critical infrastructure employee per [Federal Critical Infrastructure Guidelines](#) .
- The employee should wear a face covering at all times while at work for 14 days after the last exposure.
