Time is stockpiled as per state law to allow for up to thirteen days of school being missed due to "dangerous or extreme weather conditions" or "upon approval by the [SDE] Commissioner . . . in case of natural disaster, serious outbreaks of illness affecting or endangering students or staff, or dangerous structural or environmental conditions rendering a school unsafe for use." Days stockpiled in this manner are NOT subject to being "taken off" if not used in a school year. [TCA 49-6-3004] One day, February 21, will be identified as a stockpile day request of the Tennessee Department of Education to use as a parent conference day in the Spring term.

State regulations require 10 administrative & inservice days. At least 5 of these days must be used for inservice, and 1 administrative day must be a parent conference day.

This calendar schedules four [4] administrative days in addition to two [2] parent conference days, one as an administrative day, and one as a stockpile day (February 21).

This calendar designates three [3]required local inservice days in schools, with August 04, January 16, and February 20 as optional dates for earning the fourth and/or fifth inservice day, OR hours for the fourth and fifth day may be earned by teachers with documented activities assigned by principals at times other than school hours in summer or

Remaining inservice days [2] may be earned through activities chosen by a teacher outside statutory paid days of this calendar only with principal approval.
