The candidates that interview and progress into the program will complete the following requirements:

1. Program Requirements

- a. Complete 33 credit hours for Master of Education degree, which includes your requirements for Tennessee teacher's licensure with a GPA of 3.0 or higher to complete the license.
- b. Must pass subject area Praxis prior to being put on a Practitioner's license.
- c. Must complete one year of teacher apprenticeship OR be placed on a permit by the school district.

2. Expectations of Prospective Students

- a. Completed bachelor's degree from an accredited institution (any subject) with 2.75 min. Gpa
- b. Cannot have any previous teaching license (apprentice, practitioner, professional)
- c. Availability to attend one class per week, either online or in person (5:30-9:30 pm Central time), for two years (year-round). (Two classes per week in Summer semester.)
- d. Ability to study for and complete homework assignments (including writing papers and research) for one class every eight weeks for two years (year-round)
- e. Ability to study for and pass all required Praxis exams (depending on subject area)
- f. Ability to take a job as full-time teacher of record, when offered (apprenticeship)

3. Praxis Testing

- a. Subject area Praxis (number of exams depends on subject area)
- b. Teaching Reading Praxis (for grades K-8 and SPED)
- c. EdTPA

4. Licensure Requirements

- a. Pass all required Praxis exams, including 5205 for K-8 and SPED, and EdTPA.
- b. Teach for at least one academic year (two semesters) as teacher of record in the district.
- c. Submit portfolio to include 50 hours of field experience
- d. Submit TEAM evaluations from TNCompass
- e. District-provided mentorship until enrollment complete with Lipscomb University

- c. LiveText license (for portfolio)
- d. Praxis and EdTPA vouchers and study materials (vouchers at study.com)
